## **NOTICE TO REAL ESTATE SELF FILERS**

## HB 1292 Changes EFFECTIVE 1/1/2025

## Georgia law requires:

- All self-filers MUST **EFile** real estate documents at: <a href="https://efile.gsccca.org">https://efile.gsccca.org</a>
- All individuals eFiling MUST have their identity verified through the Clerks'
  Authority eFile portal, <a href="https://efile.gsccca.org">https://efile.gsccca.org</a>. There are no exceptions.
- The following groups may file via paper or may choose to efile:
  - 1. Georgia licensed Title Insurance Companies
  - 2. Georgia licensed Attorneys
  - 3. Georgia licensed Real Estate Brokers or Salespersons
  - 4. Bank or Credit Union with Federal Deposit Insurance
  - 5. Georgia licensed or exempt Mortgage Lenders
  - 6. Mortgage servicer (as such term is defined in 12 C.F.R. Section 1024.2)
  - 7. Public official in the capacity of official duties
  - 8. Georgia licensed Land Surveyor

Before coming to the Clerk's office to efile a document on our public terminal you must have:

- 1. An efile account set up at: <a href="https://efile.gsccca.org">https://efile.gsccca.org</a>
  To set up a validated efiling account you will need:
  - o a valid email address
  - o a valid driver's license or government issued photo ID
- 2. Original document and a digital copy of executed document with PT61(if needed)
